

Opening Lifeguard

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Lifeguard's first and foremost responsibility is to prevent accidents from occurring in and around the pool. YMCA Lifeguards must respond appropriately to accidents and incidents, performing water rescues, CPR and first aid as needed and enforcing Pool Rules and Y policies. The Lifeguard must remain alert and be prepared at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current YMCA or American Red Cross Lifeguard certification.
- Title 22 First Aid, Certified Pool Operator or equivalent, Lifeguard Instructor, CPR and First Aid Instructor certifications preferred.
- Certification requirements, within 30 days of hire, include: completion of: Child Abuse Prevention; Blood-borne Pathogens and Oxygen Administration.
- Successful water skills test prior to hire.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Adheres to all safety policies, rules and standard operating procedures established by the Y.
- Inspects, corrects and maintains the work station/environment to ensure it is free from hazards or unsafe conditions.
- Communicates swiftly and effectively with internal and external emergency personnel.
- Maintains active surveillance of the pool area.
- Knows all emergency procedures and responds to emergency situations immediately in accordance with YMCA policies and procedures.
- Knows, understands, and consistently applies safety rules, policies and guidelines for the pool and aquatic area.
