QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High School graduate or GED
2. Prior experience working with children.
3. At least 18 years of age.
4. Certification requirements include, within 30 days of hire, CPR/AED, Child Abuse Prevention.
5. Excellent interpersonal skills.
6. Strong verbal and written communication skills.
7. Ability to communicate with parents, coworker's, campers and visitors in a pleasant and professional manner.
8. MUST be available for full duration of camp.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Maintains sight and sound supervision of a group of children at all times.
2. Ensures developmentally appropriate adult-child interactions.
3. Plans and implements program activities that is culturally relevant, age-appropriate and consistent with YMCA values.
4. Adheres to ACA standards and Summer Camp Staff training Manual, including safety and cleanliness standards.
5. Attends all staff meetings and trainings.
6. Follows YMCA policies and procedures, including those related to medical and disciplinary, child abuse prevention and emergencies.
7. Maintains positive relationships with parents and families.
